SOC 1: Internal Controls Over Financial Reporting (ICFR)

A SOC 1 report focuses on controls relevant to your clients' financial statements and assesses how well a service organization's controls impact the financial reporting of its user entities. It is commonly used by:



Fund administrators



TPAs



Payroll processors



Loan servicing companies



Auditors of user entities

If your services affect your clients' financial reporting, a **SOC 1 Type I or Type II** report helps streamline their audits and build long-term institutional credibility.

SOC 2: Security, Availability, Processing Integrity, Confidentiality & Privacy

A SOC 2 report evaluates the effectiveness of your organization's IT controls. It helps meet:

- Vendor due diligence standards
- Cybersecurity and data protection requirements
- Regulatory frameworks (e.g., HIPAA, GDPR, GLBA)

- This report is essential if your customers, partners, and other stakeholders need detailed information about your security, data privacy, or cloud infrastructure.

SOC 3: Public-Facing Compliance Reporting

A SOC 3 report is a high-level summary of your SOC 2 controls, designed for public distribution and often used for marketing and building trust with potential customers. It offers:

- A seal of approval for your organization's IT systems
- A marketing and trust-building tool for your website or sales materials
- Transparency without exposing technical detail
